Did you know?

The Kalāheo High School Foundation was established by the **Kalāheo faculty** when, in 1992, teachers decided to use as seed money the school's National Blue Ribbon Schools Award of \$4000, thereby benefiting students in perpetuity.

While fulfilling the Foundation's mission to provide a growing endowment, the Board has awarded **\$16,400 in school grants** for computers, special programs, student publications, classroom fans, chairs, production equipment, books, air conditioning and other needs.

With the support of former Kalāheo principal Dr. James Schlosser and woodshop teacher Art Fitchett, the **History and Pride Wall in the school office** is a Foundation project to honor school leaders and notable alumni. The wall highlights current events, the half-century history of Kalāheo Intermediate/Kalāheo High School, and alumni accomplishments.

The **Christine Snyder 9/11 Memorial**—tree (2002) and stone marker (2006)—is a Foundation project with monetary and *pro bono* support from alumni, Ameron Hawaii, and stone sculptor Doug Jones.
